Velo Club Flintham has been affiliated to British Cycling since 2013 and has grown from strength to strength – thanks to the enthusiasm and dedication of our members. Whatever your reasons for joining, we have several regular club events aimed at meeting the needs and levels of all our members. We are always looking for volunteers to help organise and lead our rides and we also encourage you to create your own event for others to join. We have a strict **non-drop** policy – we will **never** leave a member behind.

Membership

Your membership of Velo Club Flintham is £5.00 for the whole year and is due on 1 January, *regardless of the month you joined and is accepted exclusively through British Cycling:* <u>www.britishcycling.org.uk</u> You will be sent a reminder when your renewal is due.

Love the ride

Our regular club-organised rides include: -

<u>Sunday mornings</u> – these rides take place throughout the year and are our core event. There are usually two rides on offer, 35 and 50 miles, led by volunteers, (in time we would hope you will volunteer too)! The ride is split into groups to manage numbers and match abilities and there is always a café stop where we all meet up if we can. Rides usually start at 9am <u>prompt</u> from VCF HQ (address at top). Parking is available at the pavilion. *During the winter months or inclement weather, the ride leader/s may decide on a slightly later start time.* Details of rides and routes are posted before each weekend.

<u>Chain Gang</u> – held weekly on Wednesday evenings from the end of March till early September. A challenging evening ride starting at 6.30pm from VCF HQ. A 20.2 mile loop ridden at a faster pace on the same route each week, split into groups to manage numbers and match abilities. **Friday evening social** – Occasional Friday night social rides are posted. You could post one! They end in a pub. As the title describes, it's a 'social' not fast, just fun!

Beginners 20 – held on request: an opportunity for newcomers and beginners, or for anyone getting back into cycling. Basics of group riding and safety are covered during the ride. Also includes a café stop at the halfway point. Start time and meeting point as above.

<u>Special events</u> are organised throughout the year, including rides to celebrate Easter, summer rides, our birthday, Halloween, Remembrance Day, Christmas and usually a fundraising ride.

Our annual 100-mile sportive, the 'Flintham Flower' is a fun event consisting of 4 X 25 mile routes. You can complete as many, or as few as you wish. We will of course 'encourage' you to complete all four **and** you get cake at the end of every 25miles!

Safety

Velo Club Flintham fully supports safe and responsible group riding. Helmets <u>must be worn</u> on all club rides and compliance with the Highway Code is expected.

The minimum age for joining the club is 18. We welcome younger cyclists but they MUST be accompanied for the duration of the ride by a parent or legal guardian who will be solely responsible for their safety and well-being. The accompanying adult must have assessed that the ride is suitable for the underage cyclist.


The committee also request that as a curtesy to other members, you use rear mudguards during the winter months.

Group riding tips for all: please spare a few minutes to look at this video on the basics of group riding. Log on to British cycling and search for 'How to ride in a group.'

Medical Conditions – As a duty of care, the committee request that all members carry ICE (in case of emergency) information on every ride and inform the ride leader of any medical condition that might affect their ride (i.e. allergic reaction to a wasp/bee sting, requiring the use of an Epi-pen).
