BC AFFILIATION RENEWAL/MEMBERSHIP FEE 2024

- RB reported that he'd paid the Cycling Time Trials renewal but that it had increased from £30 in 2023 to £60 for 2024. To be discussed before the end of 2024 – whether to continue paying CTT in future.
- RB reported that he'd paid the British Cycling Club renewal for 2024 at a cost of £74 receiving a discounted rate for early payment.
- After discussion, the committee decided to leave annual subs at £5 for 2024 and everyone agreed that all members <u>must</u> renew via the British Cycling website and not via the club account.
- Treasurers Report update we currently have a balance of £1,910.87 after CTT & BCC payments. There is no outstanding expenditure other than payment for any kit ordered.
